3. Strengthens personal power and self-confidence. It enhances inner strength, courage, and boosts self-assurance for overcoming difficulties.



4. Enhances spiritual growth and divine connection. It deepens devotion and fosters a stronger bond with the divine, aiding spiritual evolution.



5. Brings prosperity, health, and happiness. It bestows abundance, well-being, and lasting joy upon the individual and their family.



6. Pleases Lord Shiva and bestows His blessings. The ultimate goal is to please the Supreme Lord Shiva and receive His divine grace.
